

Gender Issues.

Info pack

Summary of the project:

Seven groups, 56 young people, from East and West Europe will meet from 12th to 20th of July 2019 in the youth educational center “Wolfsberg” in Kranenburg for a youth exchange on the topic: “Gender Issues”. The groups come from Belarus, Russian Federation, Estonia, Germany, Romania, Turkey and Ukraine. The project is aimed at young people aged 15 to 25. In most societies, many things have gotten going in recent years when determining gender roles; the traditional division between men and women is being called into question almost everywhere. This is where young people need support in their search for values on which they can orient themselves. The young people in this youth exchange come from very different cultural backgrounds.

During the project they will think about their own gender role and not take it as "natural" or self-evident. Participants will learn that they can develop these independently. They will learn a distance to homophobia and that sexuality can also be lived by people in different manifestations. This diversity does not threaten anybody but gives individuals - including young people - the chance to unfold their needs. Among others greater emphasis should be placed on the fact that sexual orientation or a specific sexual identity must not be a reason for discriminatory behavior.


All the events and discussions of the project will be held in non-formal educational format and participants will rethink the topic in a creative way – by working together in 5 workshops. Aside from the non-formal learning, we also value good relationship between all participants and the informal learning a lot.

Dates:

APV: 14th – 17th of June 2019

Main meeting: 12th – 20th of July 2019

For the APV two persons are invited: One leader and one young person > 30 years old. The persons who come to the APV also **MUST** come to the main meeting!!!! The APV starts with the dinner at 18h and ends on Monday after breakfast.



For the **main meeting** please note the number of participants per country:

Germany – 12 (4 leaders);

Estonia, Russia, Belarus, Turkey – 7 (1 leader);

Ukraine, Romania – 8 (2 leaders).

Please be there till 18h in the evening and the meeting will end on the 20th of July with the lunch at 12h. This is vitally important for each group **not to leave the venue before 12h** on the 20th of July! **Please look for flights now and send us a proposal.**

Nearest airports are Dortmund, Dusseldorf, Cologne and Weeze. Check the next page “How to reach the venue” to review the logistical issues.

Don't book flights without our confirmation if you want to get money back! The lump sum for the flights from *Russia is 530€, for Turkey 360€, for all other groups 275€.*

From Düsseldorf International Airport

To get to the train station “Bahnhof Düsseldorf Flughafen” from your terminal take the SkyTrain. You don't need any ticket for it.



From station “Bahnhof Düsseldorf Flughafen” take the fast train **ABR RE19** (every hour from 6:33am till 21:33pm) – direction Arnhem Centraal. Change at **Emmerich** (station Bahnhof, Emmerich am Rhein). Take the bus **SB58** (each hour from 6:51am till 22:51pm) – direction Nijmegen Centraal Station and your stop is **Bomshof, Kranenburg (Niederrhein)**. To the hostel you have to go about 15-20 minutes.

FOR THE WHOLE TRIP YOU NEED JUST ONE TICKET. For a group of up to 5 people take the **Shöner Tag Ticket NRW** for 46 EUR. Don't forget to write the names of passengers on it. This ticket is valid for the whole day. And you can also buy the same ticket for the way back, just pick the certain date of travel while purchasing it. If you buy the return ticket you will get the reimbursement for that already during the meeting.

If you are in a group of more than 5 people/if you travel alone - take **Single Ticket, Tarif stage D** for 15,7 EUR. This ticket is valid for 2 hours. It is enough to get to Kranenburg.

Both tickets are valid for all types public transport **except IC, ICE trains.**

From Dortmund Airport

Take the BusAirpo (every 30 to 60 min.) to Hauptbahnhof Dortmund (Central Station) - 9 EUR, 25 minutes. Or **Bus 490** direction Aplerbeck and change there to the tram U47 (Westerfilde) to reach **Dortmund Central station** - for this way your **NRW Shöner Tag Ticket** is valid, but the way will take 40 min. At the Dortmund Hauptbahnhof take the **train RE3** - direction Düsseldorf Hbf (40 min., 6 stops), Change at **Oberhausen Hbf** and take the next **train RE19** - direction Arnhem Centraal - to **Emmerich**. From Emmerich central station (Bahnhof, Emmerich am Rhein) take the **bus SB58** (each hour from 6:51am till 22:51pm) - direction Nijmegen Centraal Station and your stop is **Bomshof, Kranenburg (Niederrhein)**. To the hostel you have to walk about 15-20 minutes.

FOR THE WHOLE TRIP FROM DORTMUND HBF YOU NEED JUST ONE TICKET. For a group of up to 5 people take the **Shöner Tag Ticket NRW** for 46 EUR. Don't forget to write the names of passengers on it. This ticket is valid for the whole day. And you can also buy the same ticket for the way back, just pick the certain date of travel while purchasing it. If you buy the return ticket you will get the reimbursement for that already during the meeting.

If you are in a group of more than 5 people/if you travel alone - take **Single Ticket, Tarif stage D** for 15,7 EUR.

Both tickets are valid for all types public transport **except IC, ICE trains**.

NOTE: tickets for the BusAirpo you can buy only in the bus. And they are valid just for this bus.

From the airport Weeze

Take the **Bus SW1** (every 60 min.) to **Bahnhof Weeze** (Central Station Weeze - 11 min.), At the Bahnhof Weeze take the **train RE10 to Kleve** (18 min.), At the Bahnhof Kleve you can take the **bus 55** (18 min., 10 stops) - direction Feuerwehr or the **bus SB58** - direction Nijmegen Centraal Station and your stop is **Bomshof, Kranenburg (Niederrhein)**. To the hostel you have to walk about 15-20 minutes.

FOR THE WHOLE TRIP YOU NEED JUST ONE TICKET for 6-10 EUR - **EinzelTicket Erwachener**. The single ticket is valid for all of public transport (except IC, ICE) for 2h. For a group of up to 5 people you can also purchase **Shöner Tag Ticket NRW** for 46 EUR (one ticket for the whole journey).

From Cologne/Bonn Airport

Take the **train RE8** (direction Rheydt-Odenkirchen) to **Cologne Messe/Deutz**. Change there for train **RE5** (direction Wesel) and go to Düsseldorf Hbf. From **Düsseldorf Hbf** take a train **NWB RE10** to Kleve. At the Bahnhof Kleve you can take the **bus 55** (18 min., 10 stops) - direction Feuerwehr or the **bus SB58** - direction Nijmegen Centraal Station and your stop is Bomshof, Kranenburg (Niederrhein). To the hostel you have to go about 15-20 minutes.

For this trip you need one ticket to go to Düsseldorf (**VRS-Tarif Preisstufe 5** 11.9 EUR) + another ticket (**VRR-Tarif EinzelTicket Erwachener Preisstufe D** 15.7 EUR) for the second part of journey.

If you travel with a group of up **TO 5 PEOPLE YOU NEED JUST ONE TICKET – Shöner Tag Ticket NRW** for 46 EUR (one ticket for the whole journey). It is valid the whole day for all types of public transport except IC and ICE trains.

From the Eindhoven Airport

Take the **bus 400/401** to Eindhoven Station. From there take IC train direction Enkhuizen to **'s-Hertogenbosch**. Change there to another IC train in direction Nijmegen. Change at Nijmegen and at the Nijmegen Central Station take a **bus SB58** (30 min., 24 stops) – direction Emmerich Bahnhof and your stop is **Bomshof, Kranenburg (Niederrhein)**. To the hostel you have to walk about 15-20 minutes. The whole trip costs nearly 20 EUR (choose the ticket: train to Nijmegen + Bus) Group ticket is available for 4-7 pers. From the airport Schiphol Amsterdam

Take the IC train (1h 32 min., 7 stops) – direction Nijmegen. Change at **Nijmegen** and at the Nijmegen Central Station take a **bus SB58** (30 min., 24 stops) – direction Emmerich Bahnhof and your stop is **Bomshof, Kranenburg (Niederrhein)**. To the hostel you have to go about 15-20 minutes. The whole trip costs 23,10 EUR (choose the ticket: train to Nijmegen + Bus) Group ticket is available for 4-7 pers.
